CAMAS PRAIRIE COWBOY CONVENTION

UKIAH RODEO

June 24 and 25th 2022

Narrative

This will be a two day rodeo event with slack on Saturday morning. We have petitioned to be sanctioned with Idaho Cowboy Association and are awaiting approval. Ukiah has historically had a rodeo in and around the area. It has come and gone over the years and the Camas Prairie Cowboy Convention (CPCC) has decided to bring it back. CPCC has created a board of directors and formed a non-profit 501 c(3). CPCC has put numerous hours into planning and developing our plan to host a sanctioned rodeo. CPCC believes that the rodeo will bring an economic boost to our local community and put Ukiah back on the map.

Dates – hours

The rodeo will take place beginning on June 24 running from roughly noon till midnight. Attendance is expected to be around 600 people including contestants

Saturday the 25th will be the second day of the rodeo running from 10 am till roughly 10 pm. Attendance is expected to be around 600 people including contestants

Vendors

We are expecting 4-6 vendors including a beer garden on the west side of the arena.

Parking

Parking will be on the south end of the grounds. Area will be mowed for fire protection and a water truck will water the travel areas to prevent dust build up.

Restrooms

Porta potties will be brought in with wash stations and placed at the west end of the arena as well as near the contestant parking area.
