2021-2022 Budget Transfers

Scheduled for June 1, 2022

Twelve budget transfers are scheduled for consideration on June 1, 2022. The orders under consideration are attached and referenced by order number for your convenience.

Budget Order 2022-58 General County Program

The <u>General County Program</u> requires a Transfer of Appropriation to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Transfers Out of \$140,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$140,000.

Budget Order 2022-59 Parks Program

The <u>Parks Program</u> requires a Transfer of Appropriation to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Personnel Services of \$10,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$10,000.

Budget Order 2022-62 Emergency Management Program

The <u>Emergency Management Program</u> requires a Transfer of Appropriation to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Capital Outlay of \$10,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$10,000.

Budget Order 2022-63 On-Site Septic Program

The <u>On-Site Septic Program</u> requires a Transfer of Appropriation to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Materials & Services of \$13,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$13,000.

Budget Order 2022-65 **Stimulus Reserve Program**

The <u>Stimulus Reserve Program</u> requires a Transfer of Appropriation to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires a decrease in Capital Outlay of \$140,000 and in increase in Transfers Out of \$140,000.

Budget Order 2022-66 Board of Commissioners Program

The **Board of Commissioners Program** requires a Transfer of Appropriation to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Personnel Services of \$5,000, an increase in Materials & Services of \$10,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$15,000.

Budget Order 2022-68 Victim Witness Program

The <u>Victim Witness Program</u> requires a Transfer of Appropriation to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires a decrease in Personnel Services of \$3,000 and an increase in Materials & Services of \$3,000.

Budget Order 2022-69 Administrative Services Program

The <u>Administrative Services Program</u> requires a Transfer of Appropriation to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Personnel Services of \$5,000 and a decrease in Materials & Services of \$5,000.

Budget Order 2022-70 Veterans Services Program

The <u>Veterans Services Program</u> requires a Transfer of Appropriation to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires a decrease in Personnel Services of \$18,000 and an increase in Materials & Services of \$18,000.

Budget Order 2022-72 **GIS Program**

The <u>GIS Program</u> requires a Transfer of Appropriation to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires a decrease in Personnel Services of \$10,000 and an increase in Materials & Services of \$10,000.

Budget Order 2022-73 Community Corrections

The <u>Community Corrections Program</u> requires a Transfer of Appropriation to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Capital Outlay of \$32,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$32,000.

Budget Order 2022-74 Fleet Management

The <u>Fleet Management Program</u> requires a Transfer of Appropriation to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Capital Outlay of \$200,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$200,000.
