2021-2022 Supplemental Budgets

Scheduled for April 6, 2022

Four Supplemental Budget are scheduled for consideration on April 6, 2022. The orders under consideration are attached and referenced by order number for your convenience.

Budget Order 2022-48 GF: GIS PROGRAM

The <u>GIS Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Local Revenue of \$4,500, an increase in State Revenue of \$22,000 and an increase in Materials & Services of \$26,500.

Budget Order 2022-50 **GF: COMMUNICABLE DISEASE**

The <u>Communicable Disease Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Local Revenue of \$4,000, an increase in State Revenue of \$1,351,543, an increase in Personnel Services of \$181,709, an increase in Materials & Services of \$25,151 and an increase in Contingency of \$1,148,683.

Budget Order 2022-51 CARE

The <u>CARE Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Local Revenue of \$22,000, an increase in State Revenue of \$14,980, an increase in Personnel Services of \$15,000 and an increase in Materials & Services of \$21,980.

Budget Order 2022-52 FACILITIES RESERVE

The <u>Facilities Reserve Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Beginning Cash Balance of \$400,000, an increase in State Revenue of \$1,800,000, an increase in Capital Outlay of \$3,200,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$1,000,000.
