Business Items

CDBG for PATH Project – Chair Shafer opened the public hearing at 3:01 pm. Presented by Judy Vicek, Ducote Consulting. The County is seeking to file an application for a grant through the Community Development Block Grant Homeless Shelter program. The grant would be to fund indoor and outdoor kitchen facilities at the PATH project. One of the conditions of the grant is to conduct a public hearing to obtain input from the public on the grant and the project. Chair Shafer called for comments in favor of, opposed to or neutral. Ms. Vicek read the public notice for the public hearing to the Board.

Commissioner Timmons, I sit on the CAPECO board, I have questions as to how many beds are being serviced. There was discussion as to whether or not there were 49 beds available. Commissioner Dorran explains that they have turned in the number of rooms they are approved for. You can only house the number that you can serve. This grant to update the kitchen will allow for them to be able to serve more. Commissioner Timmons, I wonder about their barriers, they have a higher barrier and some people don't want to follow rules. The huts have a higher barrier, there are a certain amount of days that they have to display that they are responsible enough in the warming area before they can get to the huts, drugs or alcohol are not allowed on-site, certain conditions have to be met Commissioner Dorran also commented that 49 is more than the number required by the grant. No further questions or comments. The public meeting was closed at 3:17pm. Commissioner Dorran moved to approve the grant for the indoor and outdoor kitchen facilities and adopt Order No. BCC2024-058. Seconded by Commissioner Timmons. Carried, 3-0.
