A field and office search was made for the southeast corner of Section 22 and the east 1 Cor. of Sec. 22, without success. These corners were originally established in 1865, and re-established by Arnold in 1887. The last record of these corners being located that I could find was in 1914 by Willard Bradley. The old existing fence line running southerly from the county road seems to be the best evidence for the location of the property line. I recommended to client that he seek a boundary line agreement with his neighbor to the east.

I wrote a legal description for the tract I surveyed, tying it to the the W. $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. Sec. 22, and calling for my pins to control the W. boundary, and calling for the E. line of White's property for control of the E. boundary.

All measurements shown on my survey were derived from closed traverse using a 10 sec. theodolite and infra red distance meter. Bearings are true, based on a survey dated 2-25-81 by Wallulis for Robert Harris.
