


VICINITY MAP
1" = 1000'




- denotes set $\frac{5}{16}'' \times 30''$ iron pin with aluminum cap stamped PLS 933

NARRATIVE

The purpose of this survey was to establish the boundaries of a parcel to be deeded to Gilbert Ronches out of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 26, T11N, R32E, W.M., being purchased by Ron Deutz.

The West line of Section 25 was established by establishing the corners from existing fence lines and the centerline of the County Road. No corners or subsequent monumentation were found and the County Records show no surveys in this or adjoining sections of any value in establishing the Section line. Checking with local landowners verify that these fence lines have been in their current locations for a number of years, (30+ years).

Bearings are based upon ties to a survey made by the Bureau of Reclamation dated 1938, County Surveyor No. H-2558. The Bearing from the Northwest corner of Section 24 to the W.C. monument 118.34 feet North was held and used on this project. The distance from the Southwest corner of Section 25, used in this survey to the Northwest corner of Section 24 established by the Bureau of Reclamation is only 11 feet longer than the record GLO distance.
