


RECORD SURVEY

SURVEYOR'S NARRATIVE


THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO RE-SET THE BRASS CAP STREET MONUMENT NEAR THE INTERSECTION OF STATE HIGHWAY NO. 730 AND DRAPER ROAD. THIS MONUMENT WAS SET BY LANGLITZ IN HIS 1987 SURVEY FOR UMATILLA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS (88-38-B). SAID MONUMENT WAS DESTROYED DURING RECENT CONSTRUCTION OF STATE HIGHWAY NO. 730. IN ADDITION THE PROPERTY CORNER AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THAT PROPERTY SURVEYED BY EDWARDS IN 1991 FOR THE PORT OF UMATILLA (91-55-A) WAS DISTURBED AND WE RE-SET IT. THE TWO SURVEYS ABOVE AND THE MONUMENTS SHOWN HERE AS FOUND WERE USED AS THE BASIS FOR RE-SETTING THE MONUMENTS.
