

NARRATIVE:

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THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO STAKE
THE NORTH LINE OF THAT TRACT OF LAND
DESCRIBED IN A DEED TO BEVERLY PECK RECORDED
ON REEL 343, PAGE 357, UMATILLA COUNTY DEED
RECORDS, SO A FENCE CAN BE BUILT.
IN MY 1991-2 COUNTY MONUMENTATION
SURVEY I REESTABLISHED THE NW CORNER AND W
1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21 USING THE CENTER
LINE OF CO. RD. #1194 WHICH WAS SURVEYED IN
1907 AND CONFIRMED BY A FENCE LINE AT THE W
1/4 CORNER. I STILL FEEL THOSE LOCATIONS ARE
THE BEST FOR SURVEYS DONE WEST AND
NORTHWEST OF SAID NORTHWEST CORNER BECAUSE
A PROPORTIONAL LOCATION WOULD PLACE SAID
CORNER STILL 15 FEET FURTHER NORTH OF MY
LOCATION.
IN SUBSCOUENT SURVEYS INCLUDING ONE
ODNE IN 1996 FOR VOORTHEST I HAVE CONCLUDED
THAT THE PRE 1991 LOCATION SHOULD BE USED
FOR SURVEYS IN THE NW 1/4 OF SECTION 21 AND
FOR MOST SURVEYS IN SECTION 20 BECAUSE THOSE
MONUMENTS MATCH EXISTING LINES OF POSSESSION.
IN THIS SURVEY I USED THOSE PRE 1991
MONUMENTS AND SET A NEW 5/8" REBAR AT THE
WEST 1/4 CORNER OVER THE ONE WHICH WAS 13"

WEST 1/4 CORNER OVER THE ONE WHICH WAS 13" BELOW THE SURFACE OF THE ROAD.
