



NARRATIVE:

The purpose of this survey was to establish the boundaries of those parcels being transferred from the State of Oregon to the City of Pendleton, and the boundaries of the Mental Health Facility.

The boundaries for the 72.83 acre parcel are: on the south 1-84 and the North line of Lot 10 in Section 9. The right-of-way markers for 1-84 were found and the North line of Lot 10 is as defined by a survey for Harris done by Don Staebler, P.E. The East boundary is the center of the Umatilla River as defined in that Bargain and Sale Deed to Harris Pine Mills in Book 247 of Page 60. The North boundary is the South right-of-way of the Union Pacific right-of-way. This was established by ties the existing centerline and curve data from Union Pacific Railroad drawings. The West line is as described on Page 279 of Book 71 of the Umatilla County Deed records and previously surveyed by our firm in 1978 during a survey for Gale Marshall.

The boundaries of the 5.02 acre parcel are: on the South-
west and East points were established by the State of
Oregon to show the boundaries between the Mental Health
and E.O.C.I.. The North line is the South right-of-way line
of Union Pacific Railroad as mentioned above.

The boundaries of the 3.68 acre parcel were: on the South side the North right-of-way of the Union Pacific mainline as determined above, the East boundary is the centerline of the Umatilla river as determined by the center of the Union Pacific Railroad bridge and a bearing up the river from a drawing prepared by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for the Levee construction in 1958, the North boundary is the South right-of-way old Highway 30 which is 40 feet from the centerline which we made field ties to in several places, the West boundary is the Southeasterly right-of-way of the Old O.W.R. & N. Co. mainline which was computed from an old drawing obtained from the Umatilla County Assessor's Office, the stationing tied into our previous control work on the railroad.

The Mental Health Facility survey was done using rotated bearings and distances from a survey for Eastern Oregon State Hospital by Stanley Wallulis in 1963, Umatilla County Surveyor's Office No. G-4-C.

All bearings are based upon the City of Pendleton grid. Coordinates for the section corner and the 84 right-of-way points were obtained from the City of Pendleton.
