

Narrative of survey

The purpose of this survey was to subdivide the Southeast 1/4 of Section 33, Township 4 North, Range 29 East W. M. so that it could be determined if County Road # 1184, Bartley Road, was within the dedicated Right-of-Way.

The Center 1/4 Corner was located by intersecting lines between opposite 1/4 corners, which were traversed through. The 1/16 corners were all located by single proportion on the exteriors of the quarter sections. The Southeast 1/16th corner was located by intersecting the lines between the opposite 1/16th corners. The 1/16th corners along portions of North Ash Road #1181. East Harding Avenue # 1182. South Ash Road # 1183. North Loop Road # 1175. and Stage Gulch Road # 1186 were set to increase the frequency of monumentation along these Road

Bearing Base used was N 89° 17′ 16″ E from the South 1/4 Corner of Section 33 to the Southeast Corner of Section 33 from Edward's 1994 Area 1 Umatilla County Monumentation Survey, C. S. # 95-60-B. Instrument Used was a Wild T-16 one-minute theodolite with a Wild DI-5 E.D.M.


