We do also dedicate the new easements as shown on sheet 1 of this plat. County, Dregon. The control portion of this survey was performed with a LIECA System 200 Scale 1'=200 GPS and measurements were made to the monuments shown on this page and the found monuments from survey S-97-A as shown on page one of this plat. Measurement of improvement locations and the setting of monuments were performed using a Geodimeter System 600, 3 second, Electronic Total Station. Monuments were set using radial methods. radial methods.

The monument at the northwest corner of the tract was badly disturbed and it's true location could not be determined. This monument was replaced using single proportion between the found monuments to the east and west from survey S-97-A. Two of the monuments at the southeast corner of the tract were missing.
