NARRATIVE OF SURVEY

This survey was performed at the request of Mrs. Lillian Hogeland. The purpose of the survey was to partition the lands as shown. The east, west, and south boundaries were established by record surveys R1 and R2 as shown in the legend on this plat. I established the north boundary by holding pin P4 from survey R1 as being the Northwest corner of the McMahon tract as called for in the deed recorded in Book 283, Page 545, (Dennis & Ruth Henshaw tract) and computing the deed distance along the McMahon's westerly boundary. The calls in the deeds for this area match the data shown on record survey Ri and it appears that these lands were divided based on that survey with the exception of the lines between lots. This survey was performed by a two man crew using a Geodimeter System 600 Electronic Total Station. All monuments set were set using radial stakeout methods.
