

FEATURE NOTES

- The PK nail in concrete is 18" below the surface. There is a single chain link fence post driven on the SW side of the monument as a guard post.
- A metal detector indicates this monument is still present though it is paved over. I did not dig it out as part of this survey.
- This monument position falls under a small boulder in the cape ast edge of a decorative stone landscaping area. The cape from survey 99-279-B is missing.
- This portion of the ingress egress easement adjacent to the Hopkin's property is being used as parking of vehicles for the autobody shop.
- There are natural gas meters visible on Parcel 2. The exact location of the underground supply lines has not been determined yet.
- The City of Hermiston states that the Hull property is not being billed for sewer services and is not connected to the City System. However, there is a 10 ft. easement across the Schnell property for the construction and maintenance of a sewage system. (Deed Book 337, Page 114).
- There is a 10 foot easement for the underground power line supplying the transformer on the south end of the bulk storage building. The location of this easement as shown is taken from the document in Reel 158, Page 869. The true location will need to be verified.

NARRATIVE OF SURVEY

This survey was performed at the request of Mr. Herman Hull. The purpose of the survey was to partition that property described in the Warranty Deed recorded in Microfilm Reel 649, Page 14, Umatilla County Records, as shown hereon.

Portions or all of the boundary of this property have been the subject of multiple surveys. Those surveys are indicated in the "Reference Surveys" table on this map. The north and east boundaries of this land have been held in all of the surveys except the most recent done in 1999 by Wagner. Mr. Wagner did not find the monuments along the east property line and apparently held only the record bearing to determine the location of that line. I have held the earlier monuments as representing the location of the east property line. The westerly boundary of the property is the easterly line of the railroad right of way. The O.W.R.&N. Right of Way was created on August 18, 1881 under the 1875 Act of Congress. Survey Q-1151-A placed the railroad right of way approximately 8 feet to the west of where the other surveys do and where measuring from the tracks would place it today. A later survey by the same surveyor (See R14 on this map) returned the same line as the other surveys and is now in agreement with the deeds. To locate the railroad right of way I held the centerline of the tracks, the record right of way width and the record curve data from the railroad right of way map. The most recent survey, initially done and later modified in 1999, was for a boundary adjustment. As part of that survey, new legal descriptions were provided using the dimensions from that survey to redescribe all of the exterior boundaries of this property. I have held the new description for that line that was the subject of the adjustment. The remaining lines were established from found monuements from prior surveys and as discussed

This survey was performed with a Trimble R7/R8 RTK GPS System.

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, Stephen K. Haddock, a Registered Professional Surveyor in the State of Oregon, do hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with legal monuments the lands partitioned hereon in accordance with ORS Chapter 92 as revised and that the Initial Point is a 5/8" iron repar with a yellow plastic cap stamped RSI-GBW and 02817LS set under Umatilla County survey 99-279-B. Said initial point bears North 50°08'25" West, 346.18' from the southeast corner of Block 6 of the Osborne Tract Homesites as said point was monumented in Umatilla County Survey 87-003-B. The land being partitioned hereby is described in Umatilla County instrument number 2016-6490014 and the preliminary title report by Pioneer Title Company issued November 28th, 2018 (Order Number 98685) as follows:

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

A tract of land located in the North Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 10. Township 4 North, Range 28, East of the Willamette Meridian, Umatilla County, Oregon, being described as commencing at the Northeast Corner of said Section 10; thence North 89°31'00" West along the North line of said Section 10, a distance of 1048.44 feet; thence South 00 '31'00" West, a distance of 273 feet to the True Point of Beginning for this description; thence continuing South 00 31 00 West, a distance of 796.14 feet to a point on a curve located on the East line of the Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way (the radius point of said curve bears South 63°35'20" West, 5,775.84 feet); thence Northwesterly along the arc of said curve through a central angle of 05°11'44" a distance of 523.76 feet to a point of tangent; thence North 31 36'24" West, a distance of 126.68 feet; thence South 89 31'00" East, a distance of 100.53 feet; thence North 00 28 50 East, a distance of 466.09 feet to the South right-of-way line of Elm Street; thence South 89 31'00" East along the South right-of-way line of said street, a distance of 50 feet; thence South 00 28 50 West, a distance of 233 feet; thence South 89°31'00" East, a distance of 175 feet to the point of Beginning.

Excepting therefrom any portion lying within the County Road, Street and Avenue right-of-ways.
