



NARRATIVE:

The purpose of this survey was to establish the boundaries of a triangular parcel in the Northeast corner of the Northeast corner of the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter.

No original government corners were found in searching this area, only two have been found in the entire township. Physical evidence, fence lines, road intersections and the concrete post at the center of the section were taken as the best available evidence. The relationship of the found points with the original GLO (bearing and distances) was reasonable and the points were held.

The concrete post at the center of Section 28 sits on the South edge of the roadway, 20 feet from the existing centerline. It is similar to others found around the Pendleton airport and must have been set during the development of the airbase in the early 1940's, however no drawing can be found.

Bearings are based on William R. Wells survey, County No. 88-18B. Ties to his survey are shown.
