

## NARRATIVE:

The purpose of this survey is to locate the corners of Lot 2 to see if there is encroachment from the North. I could find no original monuments on this lot so I had to survey their location from found monuments in all directions. I had used a T iron for the NE corner of Lot 3, Block 3, in a 1984 survey for Jewelt but I now find it about 3 feet 5W of where it belongs. All the monuments found fit reasonably well in relation to the original plat of "HAT ROCK TRACTS."
