

NARRATIVE:

The purpose of this survey is to stake the North line of Lot 3, Block 1, so a fence can be built. Original corners in this subdivision are very scarce. I found a 3/4" uran pipe at the Northwest corner of Lot 3, Block 2, and a 1/2" iran pipe at the Northwest corner of Lot 7, Block 1, and assumed them to be original monuments of the 1946 Plat of "CORNECL ADDITION." The 1'12" iran pipe found at the Southwest corner of Lot 10, Block 1 did not fit the other two manuments so I did not use it. I did use my 1/2" rebar at the Southeast corner of Lot G, Block 2 as it fit reasonably well with the other two manuments that I used. I did find an approximately 1'1/2" iran pipe near the rebar I set at the Northeast corner of Lot 3 but it was horizontal and the base of it was encased in a large Locust tree root and I could not expose the bend.
