


NARRATIVE

This survey was performed to set the N.W. corner of the N.E. ¼ of the N.E. ¼ of section 17, T 1 N, R 34 E. W.M. and to mark the north boundary thereof. The field notes of Wilkes Survey done in 1917 was used and the brass caps he set and I found as shown were also used for control. I measured the distance between the brass caps and proportioned it for the ¼ corner according to the manual of instructions and used Wilkes bearing of S 89° 56' E for the said line. The deed used is recorded in book 337 on page 294 of the deed records.
