NARRATIVE OF SURVEY

Location of Survey

The parcels are located in the Southwest Quarter of Section 34, Township 1 North, Range 35 East, W.M., in the Northwest Quarter of Section 3 and the Northeast Quarter of Section 4, Township 1 South, Range 35 East, W.M., Umatilla County, Oregon.

Method and Procedure

The bearings shown on the survey map are based on the bearing from the brass capped iron pipe monumenting the section corner common to Sections 33 and 34, Township 1 North, Range 35 East, W.M., and Sections 4 and 3, Township 1 South, Range 35 East, W.M. to the brass capped iron pipe monumenting the E 1/16 corner on the South line of Section 33, Township 1 North, Range 35 East being due West.

The survey was begun at the aforementioned brass capped iron pipe common to Sections 33, 34, 4, and 3. Line was extended South 2° 40' 40" East along the East side of an old road to the existing centerline of Ross Road and North 2° 40' 40" West to the intersection of the line with the Southwesterly right-of-way fence of Interstate 84. This line was used as the base line for the survey and the parcels to the East were laid offi in relation to the base line as shown on the Map of Survey. The $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pins set near the North side of Ross Road and the Southwesterly right-of-way fence are not set on the right-of-way lines and control parcel alignment only.

The Westerly line of parcels II and III (the base line for this survey) is to be mutually agreed upon as the common boundary line between parcels II and III and the Staebler ownership to the West.

Angles were measured with I second theodolite and distances were measured with infra-red distance measuring equipment and steel tape.
