
TOWNSHIP 5 NORTH, RANGE 30 EAST, OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, OREGON.

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines, T. 5 N., R. 30 E., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of section 13.

The lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved December 7, 1861.

The survey was executed by William D. Kimmel, Cadastral Surveyor, beginning May 7, 1981 and completed May 15, 1981, pursuant to Special Instructions dated May 14, 1980, for Group No. 1015, Oregon.
