

NARRATIVE:


The purpose of this survey was to establish the boundaries of a triangular piece of land that is part of lot 10 of Block 18 of Houser's Addition to the City of Pendleton.

The problem arose sometime ago when a building was built across the property line between Raley's Addition and Houser's Addition. We were instructed by the seller of the property to the South to survey and prepare a legal description for the transfer of this triangular parcel.


The North and East lines of this parcel follow the boundaries of the North and East lines of said Lot 10. These were established from a pin and concrete nail set during a survey by Wayne O. Harris & Associates in 1969. A copy of this survey was found at the City of Pendleton Engineering Department File No. 11-7651. The South line was established along an existing fence line.

Bearings are based upon the previously mentioned Wayne O. Harris survey.


- denotes set 3/8" x 30" iron pin with aluminum cap stamped PLS 933
