



### NARRATIVE:

The purpose of this survey was to partition off a parcel of ground in Block One of the Original town of Pendleton belonging to Benji Franklin.

The North line of the parcel is the face of a curb and said curbline extended, on the North side of a building occupied by Bennett Insurance.

The South line is the South line of Lots 7 and 11 in said original town. This line was established from ties to centerline monuments in South Main Street as shown on County Surveyor No. 84-35-B.

The East and West lines of the parcel were established from the same monuments.

The bearing is based upon the City of Pendleton Local Grid bearing for these monuments.
