The 1865 G. L. O. Survey set posts with mound & pits of which there is no evidence. Very few topographic ties were noted. In 1911 Willard Bradley did a private survey in Section 23 at which time he found the original mounds and stakes at the Northeast corner and the East Quarter corner of Section 23. He set stones with crosses at these corners. Using Bradley's tie to the dry gully, I measured along the down fence and the 171.90 feet came to the fence corner. Some loose stones were found, but none with visible crosses. I then measured North, along the Section line and Bradley's distance of 1300.21 feet came to a fence support jack piled with stones on the North side of North Fork Road.
