NARRATIVE OF SURVEY

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF THE UMATILLA NATIONAL FOREST, UNDER CONTRACT NO. 53-04R3-2-19. THE PURPOSE OF THE SURVEY WAS TO PARTIALLY SUBDIVIDE SECTIONS 21 AND 22, T45., R32E., W.M., UMATILLA COUNTY, OREGON AS SHOWN ON THIS MAP. THE LINE COMMON TO SECTIONS 15 AND 16, T45., R32E., W.M., WAS ALSO SURVEYED FOR LINE POSTING PURPOSES.

NATIONAL FOREST BOUNDARIES WERE POSTED WITH 6 FOOT STEEL OR WOOD FENCE POSTS AS SHOWN ON THIS SURVEY PLAT. NATIONAL FOREST BOUNDARY SIGNS 54-2 WERE ATTACHED TO POSTS ALONG THE POSTED LINE.

ACCEPTABLE EVIDENCE OF ALL PUBLIC LAND SURVEY CORNERS REQUIRED FOR SECTION SUBDIVISION AND LINE POSTING WERE RECOVERED.

BEARINGS ARE BASED ON A SOLAR OBSERVATION (ALTITUDE METHOD), TAKEN 350 FEET EAST OF THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 22.

CONTROL AND SECTION BREAKDOWN SURVEYS WERE MADE BY RANDOM CLOSED TRAVERSE WITH A LIETZ IO" EMTE THEODOLITE AND RED II INFRA-RED DISTANCE METER OR WITH A LIETZ SET 3-B I" TOTAL STATION AND LIETZ SDR 22 ELECTRONIC FIELD BOOK. THE POSTING TRAVERSE ALONG THE LINE COMMON TO SECTIONS 15 AND 16 WAS MADE BY A SINGLE RUN TRAVERSE, CLOSING BEARINGS ON A SOLAR OBSERVATION NEAR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 15. OFFSETS TO POSTED LINE WERE MADE WITH A HAND COMPASS AND STEEL TAPE FROM CONTROL AND POSTING POINTS.

MANY OF THE FOREST BOUNDARIES HAVE BEEN MARKED WITH METAL NATIONAL FOREST BOUNDARY SIGNS (NAILED TO TREES) IN PAST YEARS. THERE IS EVIDENCE THAT RECENT AND OLDER LOGGING OPERATIONS HAVE USED THE SIGNS AS THE COMMON BOUNDARY. DUE TO EVIDENCE THAT PAST LOGGING OPERATIONS HAVE USED THE OLD SIGNS, THEY WERE NOT REMOVED.
