

NARRATIVE:

The purpose of this survey is to adjust the boundary of two tax lots. The description of one is the NW'4 of the SE'4. Of Section 15. The description of the alher one is the NE'4 of the SE'4 and the 5'E of the NE'4 of said Section 15 lying southerly of U.S. Hwy. #730. One of the adjusted tax lots will contain a proposed golf driving range and the other one will contain the remainder of the two tax lots.

I based this survey on my 1988 Area One monumentation survey for Ulmatilla County. In that survey, at the 5 1/4 of Section 15, I found a 2" Iron pipe near a fence corner from which the fence ran to the North and West and assumed that that pipe would fit monuments and fences in Section 15. I set a Brass Cop monument at a fence corner which ran to the South and East and assumed it would fit monuments and fences in Section 22. Just about the opposite is true. The Brass Cap I set fits fences in Section 15 better than the Iron pipe and the C.N.I/6 corner in Section 22, which was set by Staebler in a 1976 survey for NORPA using the 2" Iron pipe, falls 2 feet West and 18 feet North of an old fence corner. I therefore used my Brass Cap for this survey.
