

NARRATIVE:

The purpose of this survey is to stake the corners of that parcel of land deeded to Stanley Schnell, et ux, Book 269, Page 288, Umatilla County Deed Records, in preparation for a partition or a subdivision.

Said deed is written from the Southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section II, as were all of the deeds to the South and West of this parcel. The deed distance from said Southeast corner does not match the monuments or the lines of possession. Nor does said deed cold for the adjoining Block 4 of "LOBAUGH and STORER" subdivision on the North.

"LOBAUGH and STORER" subdivision shows 1/2 of 4.14 Street being 35 feet wide. I make it 32.43 feet wide East of Block 4.

Schnell's deed says it is 30 feet from the 1/6 line to Schnell's property and that is what I staked it at.


I used the South line of Block 4 of "LOBAUGH and STORER" subdivision for the North line of Schnell's parcel. I staked the East line 30 feet West of and parallel with the 1/16 line. For the South line I used Schnell's deed distance down from his North line which also matched monuments found on the East side of 3RD Street.

I staked this West line proportionally from his East line to monuments found on the East side of 3.00 Street. There is 2+ feet extra so I gave Schnell I+ foot and the adjoiners on the West 1+ foot.
