

NARRATIVE:

The purpose of this survey is to see how the tences and roads match the East line of that property deeded to Kenneth C. Loftus, et ux., described in a deed recorded

of that properly deeded to Kenneth C. Loftus, et us., described in a deed recorded on Reel 243, Page 876, Limatilla County Deed Records. The purpose is to also build a tence between the Northern portion of said Loftus parcel and that parcel which is described in a steed to Rauch, since the 15 fool easement on Loftus and the 10 foot easement along the West line of said Rauch property is not in use or needed any more over the North 291 feel of Loftus's parcel. See document cutting the easement off recorded in Book 327, Page 65, Umatillo County Deed Records.

There is an ambiguity in the deeds at Loftus's Southeest corner. Loftus's deed is described from one point and Schuster's deed and Sweyze's deed are described from a different point and their East-West line is described a right anales instead of along a section subdivision line as Loftus's is. The result is
