

# NARRATIVE OF SURVEY

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO ADJUST THE BOUNDARIES BETWEEN THE TWO PARCELS SHOWN ON UMATILLA COUNTY TAX MAP #4M 28 B AS TAX LOTS 10900 AND 10901. THE LARBE PARCEL (CURRENTLY T. L. #10900. AND SHOWN AS CONTAINING 77.74 ACRES) WILL SHRINK AND MOVE TO THE NORTH AND CONTAIN 9.70 ACRES. THE SMALL PARCEL (CURRENTLY T. L. #10901. AND SHOWN AS CONTAINING 9.70 ACRES) WILL EXPAND AND CONTAIN THE REMAINDER OF THE ACREAGE (80.72 ACRES).

IN ORDER TO ESTABLISH PROPERTY LINES. THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SECTION MEDDED TO BE SUBDIVIDED INTO 1/16TH SECTIONS. THE FOLLOWING MONUMENTS WERE USED: 1) KRUMBEIN'S BRASS CAP SET IN A MONUMENT BOX. C. S. #5-155-C. 1981. AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SECTION: 2) CRAMER'S RAILROAD SPIKE SET IN C. S. #84-103-A. 1984. AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF THE SECTION: 3) KRUMBEIN'S BRASS CAP SET IN A MONUMENT BOX. C. S. #5-156-C. 1981 AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF THE SECTION: 4) A 1-1/2 O. D. IRON PIPE (ORIGIN UNKNOWN) AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SECTION. UMATILLA COUNTY REMONUMENTATION SURVEY #92-45-C. WAS NOT USED. AS ALL OTHER SURVEYS IN THE AREA HAVE BEEN BASED ON THE PIPE).

THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER WAS CALCULATED BY SINGLE-PROPORTIONING IN THE WEST 1/4 (SEE RESTORATION FORM FILED SEPARATELY) AND EXTENDING A LINE FROM IT THROUGH THE AXLE SHAFT CRAMER SET IN 1974 (SURVEY UNFILED) TO THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINE BETWEEN THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER AND SOUTH 1/4 CORNER DESCRIBED ABOVE. THE BRASS CAP SET BY KRUMBEIN AT THE NORTH 1/16TH CORNER ON THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER ON SOUTH SECTION IN HIS 1977 PRAIRIE HOUSE CONDOMINIUMS. PHASE I. SURVEY (UNFILED IN SURVEY OFFICE) ONLY MISSED HITTING MY LINE BETWEEN THE NORTH AND SOUTH 1/4 CORNER BY 0.09 FEET AND WAS THE JUSTIFICATION FOR USING CRAMER'S AR SPIKE AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER INSTEAD OF THE 5/8 INON REBAR FOUND 1.66 FEET WEST OF THE SPIKE (LAGIER, 0-18-8.19/8)) THE BEARING BASE FOR THIS SURVEY WAS MOO 41 11 W FROM THE BRASS CAP AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER TO THE SPIKE AS THE NORTH SOUTH 1/4 CORNER TO THE SPIKE AS THE NORTH SOUTH 1/4 CORNER TO THE SPIKE AS THE NORTH SOUTH 1/4 CORNER TO THE SPIKE AS THE NORTH SOUTH 1/4 CORNER TO THE SPIKE AS THE NORTH SOUTH 1/4 CORNER SOUTH 1/4 CORNER TO THE SPIKE AS THE NORTH SOUTH 1/4 CORNER SOUTH 1/4 CORNER TO THE SPIKE AS THE NORTH SOUTH SOUTH 1/4 CORNER TO THE SECTION DOES NOT MATCH THE WELLS SURVEY EXACTLY BECAUSE THE RAILROAD SPIKE AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER BRASS CAP WAS USED TO CONTROL THE CENTERLINE OF SECTION LOCATION (SEE BEARING BASE DETAIL).

THE APPROXIMATE EDGE OF THE UMATILLA RIVER SHOWN ON THIS MAP WAS SCALED FROM A 1973 AERIAL PHOTOGRAPH, WHICH SHOWED THE SECTION CORNERS VERY NEAR THE ONES USED ON THIS SURVEY. IN 1979 NORMA QUICK DEEDED ALL THAT PORTION OF THE SOUTH OF THE WASTILLA RIVER TO THE CITY OF HERMISTON (REEL 75, PAGE 903). THE DISTANCES AND BEARINGS SHOWN ALONG THE SOUTHWESTERLY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL 2 WERE OBTAINED FROM THE DESCRIPTION OF THE SOUTH (EAST) BANK OF THE WASTILLA RIVER IN THE DEED FROM UMATILLA FARM LANDS COMPANY TO NICHOLAS CODD (BOOK 105, PAGE 195). THOUGH THE BEARINGS WERE ROTATED SLIGHTLY SO THAT THE DESCRIPTION INTERSECTS THE SOUTH LINE OF THE SECTION AT THE DISTANCE CALLED FOR. THE DISTANCE CALLED FOR

IN 1911.
