



# SURVEY FOR UMATILLA NATIONAL FOREST OF THE SOUTH HALF OF SECTION 35. TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST. WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN LOCATED IN UMATILLA COUNTY, OREGON APRIL. 1998

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO MAINTAIN THE EXISTING POSTING OF THE PROPERTY BOUNDARY BETWEEN PRIVATE AND NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM LANDS.

1881, GEORGE S. PERSHIN, U.S. DEPUTY SURVEYOR, SURVEYED THE EXTERIORS OF TOWNSHIPS 4 AND 5 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, AND SUBDIVIDED TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, UNDER CONTRACT NUMBER 410.

1882, GEORGE S. PERSHIN, U.S. DEPUTY SURVEYOR, SUBDIVIDED TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, UNDER CONTRACT NUMBER 430.

1975, DUANE I. GRIFFITH, REGISTERED LAND SURVEYOR NO. 644, SUBDIVIDED SECTION 3 OF TOWNSHIP S SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST FOR THE UMATILLA NATIONAL FOREST (UMATILLA COUNTY SURVEY NUMBER K 12-4).

1977, CRAIG L. WANLESS, BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT CADASTRAL SURVEYOR, REMONUMENTED THE CORNER OF SECTIONS 35 AND 36, TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST. AND SECTIONS 1 AND 2, TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST.

1980, HOWARD L. PERRY, REGISTERED LAND SURVEYOR NUMBER 1294, SUBDIVIDED SECTION 1 OF TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, FOR THE UMATILLA NATIONAL FOREST (UMATILLA COUNTY SURVEY NUMBER R 187-B).

1983—1984, DAVID H. KRUMBEIN, REGISTERED LAND SURVEYOR NUMBER 933, SUBDIVIDED SECTIONS 34 AND 35 OF TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANCE 32 BAST FOR THE UMATILLA NATIONAL FOREST (UMATILLA COUNTY SURVEY NUMBER 86—16—8).

1984, FAYETTE S. MUNRO, REGISTERED LAND SURVEYOR NUMBER 1832, SUBDIVIDED SECTION 2 OF TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST FOR THE UMATILLA NATIONAL FOREST (UMATILLA COUNTY SURVEY NUMBER 84–101–8).

FROCEDURES:
THE SURVEY WAS CONDUCTED USING A TOPCON GTS-4 TOTAL STATION. THE ANGLES
AND DISTANCES MEASURED WERE PROCESSED USING THE BUREAU OF LAND
MANAGEMENT'S PC PROGRAM WINCHM (VERSION 1.0.9B) WITH THE MEAN PROJECT
ELEVATION OF 4150 FEET. THE SURVEY MEASUREMENTS WERE ADJUSTED USING A

THE BASIS OF BEARING WAS DETERMINED USING TWO TRIMBLE PATHFINDER PRO-XR GPS RECEIVERS TO MEASURE A BASELINE FROM TRAVERSE POINT 18 (1/4 CORNER SECTION 35, T. 4 S., R. 33 E., AND SECTION 2, T. 5 S., R. 33 E.) TO TRAVERSE POINT 17. THE GPS MEASUREMENTS WERE PROCESSED USING STATIC PHASE PROCESSING TECHNIQUES (AZIMUTH FROM NORTH = 269°20'26" AND MARK TO MARK DISTANCE = 745.018 METERS).

THE BEARING TREES AND CORNER REFERENCES WERE TIED USING THE TOPCON THE BENNING TREES AND CURNEY REFERENCES WERE TIED USING THE TOPCONE STS-4 TOTAL STATION, WITH DISTANCES MEASUREMENTS TO THE BEARING TREE BEING TAKEN AT SIDE CENTER ONE FOOT BOVE THE ROOT CROWN. BEARING TREE DIAMETER'S WERE MEASURED AT BREAST HEIGHT. ALL NEW BEARING TREES DOUBLE BLAZED AND HAVE A 3/4" DIAMETER BRASS WASHER STAMPED "RLS 2308" NAILED TO THE LOWER BLAZE NEAR THE "BI" SCRIBING.

THE PROPERTY BOUNDARY WAS MAINTAINED BY SETTING ADDITIONAL METAL FENCE POSTS WITH METAL PROPERTY SIGNS ATTACHED WITHIN ONE FOOT OF THE SURVEYED PROPERTY BOUNDARY AND BY MOVING EXISTING PROPERTY BOUNDARY POSTS TO THE SURVIVED PROPERTY BOUNDARY IF THEY WERE FOUND NOT TO BE WITHIN FOOT OF THE LINE. IN ADDITION WOOD POSTS WITH ENTERING AND LEAVING MATIONAL FOREST LAND SIGNS WERE SET ON THE PROPERTY BOUNDARY WHERE AND AND LEAVING WITHIN THE PROPERTY BOUNDARY WHERE THE STATE HIGHWAY AND FOREST SYSTEM ROADS CROSSED THE PROPERTY LINE.

THE FIELD BOOK IS ON FILE AT THE SUPERVISOR'S OFFICE OF THE UMATILLA NATIONAL FOREST LOCATED AT PENDLETON, OREGON.

TRESPASS (NW 1/4 OF SW 1/4 OF SECTION 35)
THE TRESPASS LOCATED ON NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM LANDS CONSIST OF HUNTING
CAMPS WHICH WERE SETUP BY THIRD PARTIES, JAY BRITAIN AND RICK FUTTER, WHO
HAVE NO DEEDED INTEREST IN THE ADJACENT PRIVATE PROPERTY. BETAIN AND
FUTTER CLAIM THEY HAD THE VERBAL PERMISSION OF THE PRIVATE LANDOWNER,
PENDLETON RANCHES INC., TO SET UP THE CAMPS ON THEIR PROPERTY. THIS
PERMISSION DATES FROM THE 1950'S.

SINCE THIS TRESPASS SITUATION WAS FIRST IDENTIFIED IN KRUMBEIN'S SUBDIVISION OF SECTION 35 IT APPEARS THAT BRITAIN HAS ENCLOSED ADDITIONAL AREA AROUND HIS TRALLER USING A WOOD FENCE, ADDED AN CUTHOUSE AND CONSTRUCTED A FREE STANDING ROOF STRUCTURE OVER THE TRALER. FUTTER HAS MOVED IN AN ADDITIONAL TRALLER (PLACED NORTH OF THE EXISTING TRALLER) AND CONSTRUCTED A FREE STANDING ROOF STRUCTURE WITH PLYWOOD SIDES OVER THE EXISTING TRALLER.
