THIS SURVEY WAS MADE AT THE REQUEST OF GARY JELLIM OF CLEAR CREEK CATTLE COMPANY TO IDENTIFY THE NORTH-SOUTH CENTERLINE OF SECTION IN, THE EAST LINE OF THE NORTH HALF OF THE NORTH-WEST QUARTER OF SECTION IN AND THE SOUTH LINE OF THE NORTH-WEST QUARTER OF SECTION IN GAID THE SOUTH LINE OF THE NORTH-WEST QUARTER OF SECTION IN EAST OF THE RAILROAD TRACKS, THE CENTER-NORTH JIGHT CONNER WAS ESTABLISHED AND THE SUBJECT LINES MERRE MARKED MITH NOOD CUINNEYS AND LATH AT APPROXIMATELY 200 FOOT INTERVALS FOR THEICIEN PURPOSES.

PUBLIC LAND SURVEY CORNERS NOTED ON SURVEY NO. 40-50-C, 42-092-C AND 43-054-C WERE RECOVERED, TIED, AND USED AS THE BASIS FOR SECTION SUBDIVISION IN SECTIONS 18 AND 14.
