
CULP LANE RIGHT-OF-WAY ACQUISITION SURVEY

SURVEY NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO MONUMENT A STRIP OF LAND ALONG THE WEST SIDE OF COUNTY ROAD NO. 1267, CULP LANE, THAT IS TO BE ACQUIRED BY UMATILLA COUNTY FROM GARY AND VICKI CULP FOR ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY. THE PROPERTY LIES OUTSIDE OF THE ROAD THAT WAS LEGALIZED BY THE UMATILLA COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS (ORDER NO. RD2002-12) IN 2002. IT WAS DETERMINED THAT THE EXTRA WIDTH WAS NEEDED DUE TO THE SHARP CURVE AT THE NORTH END OF THE ROAD WHERE IT BECOMES PRIVATE EASEMENT. THE ROAD IS SCHEDULED TO BE REBUILT THIS SPRING THROUGH THE FORMATION OF AN L.I.D. BEARING BASE FOR THIS SURVEY IS THE SURVEY I DID FOR THE ROAD LEGALIZATION, CS#02-171-C. EXPLANATIONS OF HOW AND WHY THE RIGHT-OF-WAY WAS ESTABLISHED WHERE IT WAS CAN BE FOUND ON THAT MAP. MONUMENTS IN THIS SURVEY WERE SET USING A SOKKIA RADIAN GPS SYSTEM OPERATED IN RTK MODE AFTER PERFORMING A LOCALIZATION ON THE MONUMENTS SET IN MY PREVIOUS SURVEY.
