THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF BARNEY NEISTADT TO MONUMENT THE BOUNDARY OF A TRACT OF LAND BESCRIBED IN WARRANTY DEED RECORDED AS INSTRUMENT NO. 2004—4650401, OFFICE OF COUNTY RECORDS. THE NORTH, EAST AND WEST BOUNDARIES OF THE TRACT WERE LOCATED PER THE DEED DESCRIPTION BASED ON PARTIAL SUBDIVISION OF SECTION 27, WE LOCATED THE EXISTING CENTERLINE OF HORSESHOE RIDGE ROAD AND HELD THAT CENTERLINE AS THE SOUTH BOUNDARY OF THE TRACT. THE TRACT IS SUBJECT TO AN EASEMENT FOR HORSESHOE RIDGE ROAD. OTHER THAN THE HORSESHOE RIDGE ROAD EASEMENT NOR OF THE OTHER DEASEMENTS OR RESERVATIONS DISCLOSED BY THE RECORD DEED WERE ADDRESSED.

THE EAST BOUNDARY OF THE TRACT WAS MARKED WITH STEEL FENCE POSTS SET AT RANDOM INTERVALS. THE NORTH AND WEST BOUNDARIES OF THE TRACT WERE FLAGEORY TO BELINEATE THE BOUNDARY. 
