

SURVEY. MANY OF THE ORIGINAL PLAT MONUMENTS HAVE BEEN DESTROYED AND WERE NOT RECOVERED. AS SHOWN, SOME OF THE ORIGINAL PLAT MONUMENTS WERE FOUND BENT AND IN POOR CONDITION WHICH IS TYPICAL FOR A SUBDIVISION OF THIS AGE (1955), AND ARE NOTED. THE STRAIGHT AS TIED AND REPORTED POSITION OF THE BENT REBAR MONUMENTS WERE FOUND BY DIGGING DOWN AND FINDING THE PORTION OF THE REBAR THAT WAS NOT DISTURBED AND "TWISTING" THE REBAR CREATING A CIRCLE OF WHICH THE CENTER WAS TIED.

ALTHOUGH I DID NOT NEED TO ON THIS SURVEY, I ASSUMED AS DID SURVEY NO. 82-12-AX, THAT THE NORTH-SOUTH LOT LINES WERE INTENDED TO BE NORTH 0010' WEST OR PARALLEL WITH EAST LINE OF BLOCK ONE, HOLDING ALL RECORD EAST-WEST DISTANCES WITH THE EXCESS OR DEFICIENCY BEING APPLIED AT THE WEST SIDE OF BERGS ADDITION AT BORTHWICK ADDITION, HENCE THE CHANGE IN BEARINGS. THE BEARING DIFFERENCE IS SMALL ONLY AFFECTING THE RECORD EAST-WEST DISTANCES BY 0.09' AT MOST, WITHIN ACCURACY FOR THE DAY OF THE PLAT.

THIS SURVEY WAS MADE WITH A LEICA TOR 803 THREE-SECOND TOTAL STATION BY RADIAL METHODS, AND CLOSED TRAVERSE. NEW MONUMENTS SET WERE VERIFIED BY SEPARATE BACKSIGHT OBSERVATIONS.
