THE PROJECT UTILIZED THE 208 825071.63 8516170.02 503 825049.78 8516899.20 THE OREGON GPS REFERENCE NETWORK (ORGN) AND INDEPENDENT STATIC GPS OBSERVATIONS WITH POSITIONS DERIVED USING THE NATIONAL GEODETIC SURVEY (NGS) ON-LINE POSITIONING USER SERVICE (OPUS) WERE USED AS AN INDEPENDENT CHECK. ALL DATA WAS GATHERED IN THE OREGON STATE PLANE COORDINATE SYSTEM - NORTH ZONE (NAD83(2011)) EXPRESSED IN INTERNATIONAL FEET. DATA WAS SCALED TO THE GROUND AT #205 BY A COMBINED SCALE FACTOR OF 1.00003978158 (TO GROUND). 
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
