


EASEMENT NOTE

THE ACCESS EASEMENT PER BOOK 346, PAGE 93 IS NOT LOCATABLE WITH CERTAINTY. THE EASEMENT LOCATION WAS DETERMINED BY ANALYSIS OF DESCRIPTION INTENT COMBINED WITH THE GATE LOCATION, EXISTING HIGHWAY ACCESS POINTS AND TERRAIN.

NARRATIVE

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF MR. DOUG RYBARSKI TO MARK THE LAND BOUNDARIES AS PURCHASED AND RECORDED UNDER INSTRUMENT NUMBER 2020-6980535, OFFICE OF COUNTY RECORDS, UMATILLA COUNTY, OREGON, WHICH READS AS FOLLOWS:

COMMENCING AT THE POINT OF INTERSECTION OF THE WEST LINE OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 36 EAST OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, UMATILLA COUNTY, OREGON, WITH THE NORTH RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF THE WESTON-ELGIN HIGHWAY; THENCE SOUTHEASTERLY ALONG SAID RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE, A DISTANCE OF 210 FEET; THENCE NORTHERLY, A DISTANCE OF 210 FEET, MORE OR LESS, TO THE POINT OF INTERSECTION WITH THE SAID WEST QUARTER SECTION LINE; THENCE NORTHERLY ALONG SAID LINE, A DISTANCE OF 435 FEET; THENCE EASTERLY AT RIGHT ANGLES TO SAID QUARTER SECTION LINE, A DISTANCE OF 178 FEET; THENCE SOUTHERLY AND PARALLEL WITH THE WEST LINE OF SAID SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER, A DISTANCE OF 545 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.


THE PROPERTY WAS ORIGINALLY CONVEYED IN 1973 UNDER BOOK 331, PAGE 455, UMATILLA COUNTY DEED RECORDS. THERE IS A MINOR DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE DESCRIPTIONS WHERE THE 1973 DEED SAYS, "THENCE DUE NORTH 210 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING", VS, THE CURRENT "THENCE NORTHERLY". THE VERBIAGE DUE NORTH IS CONSISTENT WITH THE SENIOR PARCEL TO THE SOUTH (TAX LOT 600). TAX LOTS 400 AND 500 CALL FOR THEIR WEST LINES TO BE PARALLEL WITH THE WEST LINE OF THE SW 1/4 OF THE SE 1/4. I HAVE CHOSEN TO HOLD THE BEARING AS MEASURED ALONG THE WEST LINE OF THE SW 1/4 OF THE SE 1/4 TO CONTROL THE "DUE NORTH" AND "NORTHERLY" CALLS. DOING SO MAKES ALL DEEDS IN THIS AREA HARMONIOUS WITH ONE ANOTHER WHILE ALSO ALLOWING MEASURED DISTANCES TO MATCH THOSE CALLED IN THE DEEDS MORE CLOSELY.

THE WESTON-ELGIN HIGHWAY PLANS AND DEED (BOOK 170, PAGE 569) CALL FOR THE NORTH-SOUTH CENTER 1/4 SECTION LINE TO INTERSECT THE HIGHWAY CENTERLINE AT A POINT 51 FEET WEST OF THE END OF THE 500-FOOT SPIRAL CURVE. THE SOUTH LINE OF MY CLIENTS PARCEL IS CALLED FOR AS BEING PARALLEL WITH THE HIGHWAY RIGHT-OF-WAY, CREATING A SITUATION WHERE A LARGE PORTION OF THE SOUTH BOUNDARY WOULD BE IN A SPIRAL CURVE. THIS WAS NOT INTENTIONAL. GIVEN THE STRUCTURE OF THE DESCRIPTIONS, ITS APPARENT THAT THIS WAS RECOGNIZED AS BEING COMPLETELY WITHIN A TANGENT SECTION OF THE HIGHWAY. THE SPIRAL WAS OVERLOOKED. I HELD THE TANGENT BEARING AND PROJECTED NORTHWESTERLY TO THE SW 1/4 OF THE SE 1/4, MATCHING DEED DISTANCES WITHIN 0.06'. IF HOLDING THE SPIRAL, DISTANCES MEASURED WOULD DIFFER FROM THE DEED BY OVER 1-FOOT.

FOR HIGHWAY ALIGNMENT I MEASURED THE NORTH AND SOUTH EDGE OF PAVEMENT IN THREE LOCATIONS ALONG THE TANGENT AND CREATED A POINT AT MIDPOINT BETWEEN EACH. I THEN CREATED A BEST FIT LINE BY LEAST-SQUARES USING THE THREE POSITIONS. A CHECK POINT ALONG THE SPIRAL USING A LIKE METHOD MATCHED WITHIN 0.05' OF THE COMPUTED CENTERLINE.

I HELD THE POINT OF BEGINNING OF THE SENIOR PARCEL (TAX LOT 600) BEING 210 FEET SOUTHEASTERLY ALONG THE HIGHWAY RIGHT OF WAY AND 210 FEET NORTHERLY (SEE ABOVE) AS PARAMOUNT WHEN CONSIDERING REMAINING PARCEL DIMENSIONS. THE WEST BOUNDARY IS THE WEST LINE OF THE SW 1/4 OF THE SE 1/4. THE EAST LINE IS PARALLEL TO SAID QUARTER SECTION LINE WITH THE AFOREMENTIONED POINT OF BEGINNING CONTROLLING LOCATION. DISTANCES ALONG THE NORTH—SOUTH LINES HAD A MISCLOSURE OF 0.06 FEET; THIS ERROR WAS DISTRIBUTED EVENLY BETWEEN THE TWO LINES. THE NORTH LINE WAS HELD PERPENDICULAR TO THE QUARTER SECTION LINE AS MEASURED BETWEEN THE TWO CONTROLLING LINES EAST AND WEST.

BASIS OF BEARING FOR THIS PROJECT IS THE WEST LINE OF THE SW 1/4 OF THE SE 1/4 OF SECTION 25 PER PARTITION PLAT 1994-31 AND AS MEASURED BETWEEN THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 25 AND THE C-S 1/16 CORNER OF SECTION 25. DATA WAS COLLECTED WITH A 3" LEICA TS-16 TOTAL STATION USING A SERIES OF CLOSED LOOP TRAVERSES.


