NARRATIVE

THIS SURVEY HAS BEEN COMPLETED IN ANTICIPATION OF LEGALIZATION OF THAT PORTION OF ALKALI CANYON ROAD, COUNTY ROAD NO. 1361A, LYING BETWEEN HIGHWAY 74 AND WARNER ROAD, COUNTY ROAD NO. 1396, AS REQUESTED BY THE UMATILLA COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS IN BOARD ORDER NO. RD2020-13, DATED AUGUST 5, 2020. THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO DOCUMENT AND MONUMENT THE LOCATION AND WIDTH OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR THE AFOREMENTIONED PORTION OF ALKALI CANYON ROAD, PURSUANT TO ORS 368.201.

FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY DETERMINATION PURPOSES, THE PORTION OF ALKALI CANYON ROAD PROPOSED FOR LEGALIZATION CONSISTS OF TWO SECTIONS, EACH HAVING A UNIQUE SET OF UNDERLYING CHARACTERISTICS. THE FIRST SECTION IS THAT PORTION LOCATED BETWEEN STOCK DRIVE ROAD AND WARNER ROAD. THIS PORTION WAS ORIGINALLY ESTABLISHED AS OLD ROAD 225 IN 1884, WHICH ALSO MAKES UP PORTIONS OF BOTH WARNER AND STOCK DRIVE ROADS. THERE IS NO WIDTH STATED IN THE 225 ESTABLISHMENT DOCUMENTS; HOWEVER, THE FIELD NOTES MENTION MANY OFFSET STAKES AND STONES AS BEING SET 30 FEET FROM CENTERLINE, INDICATION OF A 60-FOOT RIGHT-OF-WAY. IN ADDITION, THE STANDARD WIDTH FOR ROADS IN 1884 WAS 60 FEET AND SHOULD APPLY WHEN NO WIDTH IS STATED IN ESTABLISHMENT DOCUMENTS. FOR THESE REASONS, THIS PORTION WAS DETERMINED TO BE 60 FEET WIDE, 30 FEET

THE SECOND SECTION IS THAT PORTION LOCATED BETWEEN HIGHWAY 74 AND STOCK DRIVE ROAD, COUNTY ROAD NO. 1388S. THIS PORTION OF ALKALI IS UNDOCUMENTED; NO RECORDS COULD BE LOCATED IDENTIFYING HOW OR WHEN THE ROAD WAS ESTABLISHED. ITS LONG TERM USE AND RECOGNITION AS A COUNTY MAINTAINED ROAD IS SUBSTANTIATED BY TESTIMONY FROM ADJOINING LANDOWNERS AND ROAD DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES. ITS LOCATION AND USE WAS FURTHER VERIFIED BY 1949 AND 1952 AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHY, VERIFYING THE ROAD AND ITS LOCATION HAS REMAINED UNCHANGED SINCE THAT TIME. TO DETERMINE THE WIDTH OF THIS PORTION, I USED THE FOLLOWING COMBINATION OF EVIDENCE: 1) EXISTING FENCE LINE WIDTHS THROUGHOUT THIS SECTION VARY ANYWHERE BETWEEN 45 FEET AND 67 FEET, AVERAGING OUT TO NEARLY 60 FEET. 2) THIS PORTION IS AN EXTENSION OF OLD ROAD 225, WHICH HAS BEEN DETERMINED TO BE A 60-FOOT RIGHT-OF-WAY. 3) EARLY ROAD DEDICATION DEEDS IN THIS IMMEDIATE AREA, AS SHOWN IN RECORDS R4 & R5, SPECIFICALLY CALL FOR A 60-FOOT WIDTH. 4) LANDOWNER TESTIMONY INDICATES THIS ROAD HAS EXISTED HERE SINCE EARLY SETTLERS FIRST BUILT THEIR HOMESTEADS; A ROAD CREATED IN THIS ERRA WOULD BE SUBJECT TO A 60-FOOT STANDARD. 5) THE CURRENT COUNTY ROAD STANDARD FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY WIDTH IS 60 FEET, AS ALLOWED BY ORS 368.206 AND ORS 368.036. AS A RESULT OF THIS EVIDENCE, THE ROAD IS DETERMINED TO BE 60 FEET WIDE, 30 FEET EACH SIDE OF THE CENTERLINE.

THE RIGHT-OF-WAY CENTERLINE AS SHOWN IN THIS SURVEY WAS DETERMINED BY HOLDING TOPOGRAPHIC DATA COLLECTION OF THE ROAD STRUCTURE AND COMPUTING A BEST-FIT CENTERLINE THEREOF, THE RESULTING CENTERLINE FITS THE PHYSICAL ROAD STRUCTURE WELL. TELEPHONE PEDESTALS MEASURED ALONG ALKALI CANYON ROAD BETWEEN STOCK DRIVE AND WARNER ROADS ARE 3-12 FEET WEST OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY AS SHOWN. ALL OTHER KNOWN UTILITIES ARE LOCATED WITHIN THE PROPOSED RIGHT-OF-WAY AS SHOWN.

ORIGINAL GLO CORNERS WERE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER AND WEST QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 25 AS SHOWN. THESE LOCATIONS HAVE BEEN PERPETUATED BY SETTING 2-1/2' BRASS CAP MONUMENTS. CORNER RESTORATION FORMS HAVE BEEN FILED WITH THIS SURVEY. BRASS CAP MONUMENTS AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 1, T1S, R30E AND SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 35, T1N, R30E, WERE FOUND IN GOOD CONDITION AS ESTABLISHED IN RECORD OF SURVEY 01-206-C (R14). THE CLOSING CORNER FOR SECTIONS 1 & 2, T1S, R30.5E (SHOWN AS POINT 421) IS CONSIDERED LOST AND WAS COMPUTED BY SINGLE PROPORTION BETWEEN THE AFOREMENTIONED BRASS CAP CORNERS. ALL OTHER CORNERS AS SHOWN ON THIS SURVEY ARE CONSIDERED OBLITERATED AND HAVE BEEN COMPUTED AS FOLLOWS: THE NORTHWEST CORNER AND WEST QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 14, T1S, R30.5E, WERE COMPUTED BY USING THE PHYSICAL ROAD LOCATIONS OF ALKALI CANYON, WARNER, AND STOCK DRIVE ROADS. ORIGINAL ESTABLISHMENT DOCUMENTS OF OLD ROAD NO. 225 (R3) CALL FOR THESE INTERSECTIONS TO BE THE SECTION AND/OR QUARTER SECTION CORNERS. TESTIMONY PROVIDED BY KEITH STANTON, STEVEN COREY, BOB LEVY, AND JOHN OWEN FURTHER SUBSTANTIATE THESE CLAIMS BY ASSERTING THAT THE EXISTING ROADS AND FENCES IN THE AREA ARE THE RECOGNIZED PROPERTY BOUNDARIES, CONFIRMING THEY HAVE NEVER BEEN CHANGED. THIS WAS VERIFIED FURTHER BY USED OF HISTORICAL AERIAL IMAGERY AS DISCUSSED ABOVE. THE NORTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 24, T1S, R30E, AND THE THE NORTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 24, T1S, R30.5E, BOTH CONTAIN LONG STANDING 3-WAY FENCE INTERSECTIONS (N-S-W). BY USING THE AFOREMENTIONED LANDOWNER TESTIMONY, THESE FENCE CORNERS WERE USED AS THE BEST AVAILABLE EVIDENCE OF THE QUARTER LOCATIONS AS SHOWN. THE EAST QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 24, T1S, R30E WAS DETERMINED BY HOLDING FENCE LINES EAST AND WEST FOR LATITUDE AND THE CENTER OF THE STOCK DRIVE RUNNING SOUTH FOR DEPARTURE. AGAIN, THE LANDOWNER TESTIMONY PROVIDED WAS PARAMOUNT IN MAKING THIS DETERMINATION. ODOT FIELD NOTES FROM 1921-1922 (R8) SHOW A FOUND CORNER HERE, ALTHOUGH NO DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT TYPE WAS PROVIDED. PERPETUATION OF THIS CORNER FROM THE 1922 FIELD NOTES WAS ATTEMPTED, HOWEVER; HIGHWAY 74 WAS REALIGNED IN 1954 AND THE EXISTING HIGHWAY AND RELATED RIGHT-OF-WAY MONUMENTATION PROVIDES NO DIRECT RELATIONSHIP BACK TO THE OLD 1922 ALIGNMENT, MAKING AN EXACT PERPETUATION IMPOSSIBLE. THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 24, T1S, R30E, WAS COMPUTED BY DOUBLE PROPORTIONATE MEASUREMENT BETWEEN HELD FENCE LINE INTERSECTIONS EAST, WEST AND SOUTH (POINTS 242, 244, & 423), AND THE HELD ROAD INTERSECTION TO THE NORTH (POINT 422). MODIFIED SINGLE PROPORTIONATE MEASUREMENT AS DISCUSSED IN THE BLM MANUAL (SECTION 7-34) WAS USED HERE BECAUSE OF THE ANGLE POINT AT THE ROAD INTERSECTION ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE (EAST QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 13, T1S, R30E). THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 23, T1S, R30.5E, WAS COMPUTED BY HOLDING THE SINGLE PROPORTIONATE MEASUREMENT BETWEEN THE AFOREMENTIONED NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 24, T1S, R30E, AND THE FENCE CORNER AT THE NORTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 24, T1S, R30.5E, FOR DEPARTURE, AND THE WESTERLY EXTENSION OF THE LONG TIME EAST-WEST FENCE LINE ALONG THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 24, T1S, R30.5E, FOR LATITUDE. THE RESULTING LOCATION FITS WELL WITH THAT PORTION OF ALKALI CANYON ROAD RUNNING ALONG THE SECTION LINE BETWEEN SECTIONS 23 & 24, T1S, R30.5E.

TIME AND RESOURCES DID NOT ALLOW THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT TO REMONUMENT THE SECTION AND QUARTER SECTION CORNER LOCATIONS AS SHOWN AS COMPUTED IN THIS SURVEY A PARTNERSHIP WITH THE UMATILLA COUNTY SURVEYOR HAS BEEN DISCUSSED IN AN EFFORT TO GET THESE LOCATIONS MONUMENTED ON THE GROUND. AT THIS TIME ONLY FOUND VERIFIABLE GLO EVIDENCE WAS MONUMENTED DURING THE COURSE OF THIS SURVEY.



BASIS OF BEARINGS IS OREGON NORTH STATE PLANE, NAD 83(11) (EPOCH 2010) BASED ON STATIC OBSERVATIONS COLLECTED AT CONTROL POINT #1 (SEE SHEET 4). STATIC DATA WAS PROCESSED THROUGH NGS OPUS. DISTANCES ARE GRID, INTERNATIONAL FEET. TO OBTAIN GROUND DISTANCES, MULTIPLY THOSE SHOWN BY A COMBINED FACTOR OF 1.000215757. PROJECT ORIGIN IS CP#1 AS SHOWN ON SHEET 4.

WARNER ROAD NOTE

WARNER ROAD IS NOT A PART OF THE LEGALIZATION LIMITS AS DESCRIBED IN THE BOARD ORDER AND THEREFORE WAS NOT ANALYZED AS PART OF THIS SURVEY. WARNER ROAD IS A 60-FOOT RIGHT-OF-WAY AS ESTABLISHED PER R3 & R5 (SHEET 1). THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 14 WAS COMPUTED BY USING THE PHYSICAL LOCATIONS OF WARNER AND ALKALI CANYON ROADS. 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
