# NARRATIVE

- 3. The East line of Tract II of the subject property was the East line of the West 843 feet of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 4, Township 3 North, Range 29. East of the Williamette Meridian, Umatilla County, Oregon, as calculated by breakdown of the Quarter Section, as shown hereon.
- 4. The North line of Tract I of the subject property was held along the South line of Partition Plat No. 1992-9, between the position for the Southwest corner thereof, calculated from the found monuments labeled "A" and "B", and the found monument labeled "C" at the Southeast corner thereof.

- 7. The South line of Tract II was located from Oregon Department of Transportation monuments located along the Westbound off-ramp of Interstate 84, and from Instrument No. 2005-4910067, Umatilia County Microfilm Records.
- 8. Stanfield Irrigation District was contacted for any possible record documentation for the boundaries for the Furnish Ditch; the District was unwilling to cooperate. The boundaries of the Furnish Ditch for Tract I were held at the record location described in Tract I. and found to fit well with the ditch. 
