

NARRATIVE OF SURVEY

This survey was performed at the request of the Umatilla County Surveyor, Mr. Dave Krumbein. The purpose of the survey was to re-establish and remonument the original GLO corner positions and provide NAD 83-1991 Oregon State Plane Coordinates on those positions. GPS observations to Tri Stations "Big Hill Reset" and "Pendleton" were adjusted by least squares to obtain the control for this survey.

As stated in survey 12-88-C, this township was originally surveyed by U.S. Deputy Surveyor William Lewis in 1865. The discrepancies in Mr. Lewis' work were first reported in a survey done in 1876 (in sections 4 and 9) by a Mr. Peter Zahner. (See the Record of Private Surveys Book 1, Page 397.) The survey by Mr. Zahner was examined in 1893 by the Umatilla County Surveyor. John Kimbrell who confirmed the discrepancies. Mr. Kimbrell reported finding and remonumenting several of the original corners in Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9. The current lines of occupation agree very well with the Kimbrell survey. In an effort to leave the errors where they occurred, I have held Kimbrell's record to re-establish the corners between Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9 in the following manner: I held the intersection of the field lines as the true location of the west and south 1/4 corners of Section 4. I then projected the west and south lines of Section 4 to a point of intersection to locate the southwest corner of Section 4. This location agreed with a north-south field road and with Kimbrell's distance for the south line of Section 5. I then computed the location of the west 1/4 corner of Section 9 on line between the found stone at the southwest corner of Section 9 and the northwest corner of Section 9 as just re-established using Kimbrell's record distance south of the corner to Sections 4, 5, 8, and 9. Lastly I computed the south 1/4 corner of Section 5 using the broken boundary method and Kimbrell's

Survey 95-78-B calls for monuments at the center 1/4 corners of Sections 7 and 18. There is no record of the origin of these monuments. However, they indicate that there has been prior survey work done in these sections. The possessory lines in Sections 8, 17 and 18 appear to be using the found monumentation around these sections while that in the west half of Section 7 does not.

Survey 12-03-C reports setting a 5/8" rebar at the north 1/4 corner of Section 20. The soils at this location are very shallow and I did not find that monument. I did find the monument set by C.H. Storms in survey Q-809-B in good condition and firmly set in the bedrock. The survey by Storms was done in 1948 for Mable Harris. This resulted in a law suit (Harris -v- Harris) and a survey done by the County Surveyor, F.B. Hayes (Q-1361-B) in 1949. Mr. Hayes accepted the Storms survey and it appears that the law suit was settled holding both the 1/4 corner position and the location of the Walla Walla River from the 1949 survey by Hayes. Survey 12-03-C was apparently performed without knowledge of the law suit and prior surveys and has consequently established positions contridicting the former boundary establishments in the area. I have held the position by Storms as being the true location of the 1/4 corner.

This survey was performed using a Trimble R7/R8 RTK GPS system. For additional information concerning monumentation found and set, please consult the corner certificates filed herewith.
