

AL= 661.65' UMATILLA COUNTY ROAD RECORDS RESERVATION (CTUIR) TO SURVEY AND MARK THE BOUNDARIES OF ALLOTMENT 505A, INCLUDING THE  $\Delta = 26^{\circ}27'51"$ INDICATE THAT MISSION ROAD HAS A 60' EXCEPTION FOR MISSION ROAD ON THE SW CORNER AND THE EXCEPTION FOR THE UNION PACIFIC CB= S 77'12'58" E WIDE RIGHT-OF-WAY WHICH CORRESPONDS RAILROAD ON THE NORTHWEST CORNER. THE SURVEY WAS DONE USING DUAL FREQUENCY RTK GEODETIC GPS RECEIVERS HAVING STANDARD ERRORS OF 10 MM + 1 PPM RMS IN JULY AND AUGUST CL= 655.79' WITH THE EXISTING ROAD IMPROVEMENTS. THE PERIMETER OF THE SE 1/4 OF THE NW 1/4 OF SECTION 9, T2N, R33E WAS SURVEYED AND MONUMENTED IN 2003 AND 2004 BY BLM SURVEYOR BRYAN S. SEIBOLD, THE PLAT WAS APPROVED JUNE 1, 2005. THE BLM SURVEY WAS A DEPENDENT RESURVEY AND SUBDIVISION SURVEY OF SECTIONS **MONUMENT DESCRIPTION NOTES** 4 AND 9 AND DID NOT ADDRESS THE RAILROAD OR COUNTY ROAD RIGHTS-OF-WAY THAT ARE EXCEPTED FROM 505A. CENTER WEST 1/16 CORNER - FOUND A 3" BLM BRASS CAP PER THE 2005 BLM DEPENDENT RESURVEY. ----x----x----x----x----x----x IN 1998 WILLIAM WELLS PREPARED A SURVEY FOR CTUIR OF THEIR PROPERTY LYING SOUTH OF THE 2. NW 1/16 - FOUND A 3" BLM BRASS CAP PER THE 2005 BLM RAILROAD AND NORTH OF MISSION ROAD THAT IS ADJACENT TO THE WEST LINE OF ALLOTMENT 505A DEPENDENT RESURVEY. THE NW CORNER OF THE SE 1/4 OF THE NW 1/4 OF SECTION 9 WAS NOTED AS DISTURBED AND OUT 3. 1/1024 CORNER ON THE NORTH LINE OF THE SE 1/4 OF THE OF POSITION. HE THEREFORE COMPUTED THE POSITION PER COUNTY SURVEY H-121-B. THIS COMPUTED NW 1/4 - FOUND A 3" BLM BRASS CAP PER THE 2005 BLM POSITION FALLS APPROXIMATELY 3 FEET WEST OF THE CORNER POSITION ESTABLISHED BY BLM DEPENDENT RESURVEY SURVEYOR SEIBOLD. I HAVE HELD THE BLM CORNER AND FOUND THE MONUMENT SET BY WELL FOR 4. CENTER NORTH 1/16 CORNER — FOUND A 3" BLM BRASS CAP PER THE 2005 BLM DEPENDENT RESURVEY. THE NW CORNER OF THE CTUIR PROPERTY TO BE 2.1 FEET WEST OF THE LINE. 5. AP2 ON THE EAST LINE OF THE SE 1.4 OF THE NW 1/4 -IN 2007 DWIGHT BARTLESON PREPARED A RECORD OF SURVEY FOR THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS FOR MISSION HIGHWAY (UIR 900). IN HIS NARRATIVE MR. BARTLESON STATES THE THE PURPOSE OF FOUND A 2" ALUMINUM CAP ON A 5/8" IRON REBAR. THE SURVEY WAS TO MONUMENT THE DEED CENTERLINE OF MISSION HIGHWAY. I HAVE FOUND AND 6. API ON THE EAST LINE OF THE SE 1/4 OF THE NW 1/4 -NOTED FOUR OF THE MONUMENT FROM HIS SURVEY. HOWEVER, THE LOCATION OF THE FOUND FOUND A 2" ALUMINUM CAP ON A 5/8" IRON REBAR. 7. CENTER 1/4 CORNER - FOUND A 2" BRASS CAP BY LS 1383 MOUMENTS IN THE MISSION HIGHWAY THAT RUNS THROUGH ALLOTMENT 505A DO NOT AGREE WITH THE DESCRIPTION OF THE EXCEPTION. ALSO, THE EXCEPTION IS 40 FEET IN WIDTH AND UMATILLA COUNTY ROAD RECORDS AND THE PHYSICAL LOCATION OF THE ROAD IMPROVEMENTS INDICATE THAT THE ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY THROUGH ALLOTMENT 505A IS 60 FEET IN WIDTH. FOR THIS REASON I HAVE SHOWN AN IN A MONUMENT CASE IN MISSION ROAD AS NOTED ON THE 2005 BLM DEPENDENT RESURVEY. 8. CENTER EAST 1/16 CORNER - FOUND A 2 1/2" BRASS CAP ADDITIONAL 20 FEET OF ROAD EASEMENT ADJACENT TO THE SOUTHERLY SIDE OF THE 40 FOOT IN A MONUMENT CASE IN MISSION ROAD AS SHOWN ON THE 2005 BLM DEPENDENT RESURVEY. 9. EAST QUARTER CORNER SECTION 9 - FOUND A 2 1/2" BRASS CAP IN A MONUMENT CASE AS NOTED ON THE 2005 RECORD DIMENSION BLM SURVEY BY SEIBOLD FOR THE RAILROAD EXCEPTION I HAVE HELD THE RECORD DEED DISTANCE NORTH OF THE EAST QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 9, WHICH WAS COMPUTED BASED ON THE 2005 BLM SURVEY, AS THE (XOXOX)BLM Rec'd By: CT APPROVED JUNE 1, 2005. BLM DEPENDENT RESURVEY. STARTING POINT FOR BOTH THE ORIGINAL MAIN TRACK AND RELOCATED MAIN TRACK CENTERLINE. THIS No.: 17-109-C RECORD DIMENSION PER DEED, (XOXOX)DEED LOCATION APPEARS TO FALL APPROXIMATELY 6.5 FEET SOUTH OF THE CENTER OF THE CURRENT TRACK LOCATION. THE DEED ALSO NOTES A DEFLECTION ANGLE FROM THE EAST LINE OF THE SECTION OF 85°52', HOWEVER THIS ANGLE DOES NOT AGREE WITH THE CURRENT LOCATION OF THE RAILROAD IMPROVEMENTS. I FOUND THAT A DEFLECTION ANGLE OF 84°46'29" AGREES WITH THE TANGENT SECTION OF THE TRACK LYING BOTH EAST AND WEST OF ALLOTMENT 505A. BOTH CENTERLINES WERE ESTABLISHED FROM THE BEGINNING POINT HOLDING RECORD DEED CALLS. THE ORIGINAL MAIN TRACK CENTERLINE COINCIDES WITH THE EXISTING TRACK TANGENT WEST OF THE SURVEYED PROPERTY. THE RELOCATED TRACK CENTERLINE IS 2.85 FEET NORTH OF THE ORIGINAL TRACK CENTERLINE WHEN IT GET TO THE END OF THE LAST SPIRAL ON THE WEST END. BOTH DEEDS INDICATE THAT THE CENTERLINES ARE APPROXIMATELY 993 FEET NORTH OF THE WEST QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 9. I FOUND THEM TO BE CLOSER TO 1020 FEET NORTH OF THE COMPUTED POSITION OF THE WEST QUARTER CORNER OF
