

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

The corner was originally set by Josiah Burnett under contract No. 92 dated September 12, 1860. His record reads: Set post for corner to secs. 34 & 35 drove charred stake & raised mound with trench as per instructions. The County surveyor, Aubrey Perry, records a "Rock Cor. to Sec. 34-35 in his survey recorded in Book 2, Page 301 of the Record of Private Surveys dated March 1919.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

A fence corner with fences running North, West and Southwest with many stones scattered about. The fence corner location agrees with the call for distance from the Perry survey.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)
At the fence corner I set a 30" x 1 1/2" G.I.P. with a 2 1/2" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above 28" in the ground. I nailed a County monument sign on the fence.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1 1/4" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852, and WALS 13922 as described below:

an iron rebar bears N1°21'02"E, 42.98 feet, under the existing fence;

an iron rebar bears N0°46'00"E, 74.92 feet, under the existing fence;

an iron rebar bears N88°20'00"W, 38.33 feet, under the existing fence;

an iron rebar bears N87°35'48"W, 57.84 feet, under the existing fence;

The monument and references were tied using a LIECA SYSTEM 300 RTK GPS.
