

The corner was originally set by Josiah Burnett under contract No. 92 dated September 12, 1860. His record reads: Set post for 1/4 sec. corner. Drove charred stake & raised mound with trench as per instructions.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source) None.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)

At the proportionate point I set a 30" x 1 1/2" G.I.P. with a 2 1/2" Brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above flush with the ground. I set a 5' steel guard post with a County monument sign attached along side.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1 1/4" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852, and WALS 13922 as described below:

an iron rebar bears N53°09'16"E, 21.53 feet, 12" below the surface;

an iron rebar bears S44°14'29"E, 24.08 feet, 12" below the surface:

an iron rebar bears N33°54'19"W, 28.57 feet, under the existing fence;

an iron rebar bears S26°59'33"W, 43.49 feet, at the existing fence corner:

The monument and references were tied using a LIECA SYSTEM 300 RTK GPS.
