

MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description) I set a 1 1/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above at the fence intersection.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" iron rebars with 1 1/4" orange plastic caps stamped WTS and 56295LS as described below:

an iron rebar bears N37°07'33"W, 203.58 feet;

an iron rebar bears S89°46'55"E, 121.35 feet;

an iron rebar bears S42°17'09"E, 229.62 feet;

an iron rebar bears S69°17'40"W, 31.29 feet, 2 feet below the surface of the field;

The monument was set and references tied using a Trimble R7/R8 RTK GPS system.
