At the proportionate point, I set a 1.25" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with 2.25" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram. This monument is 4 feet north of an east - west fence and and approximately 30' west of a draw bottom. The top of the monument is flush with the ground. I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 as described below: a rebar bears S87°24'E, 134.43 feet under the east - west fence line across the draw; a rebar bears \$79°20'E, 24.32 feet under the east - west fence line: a rebar bears S83°29'W, 31.28 feet under the east - west fence line: a rebar bears S88°58'W, 130.54 feet at the intersection of a north bound fence line; The bearings are true.
