Evidence Found: None Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the location of this corner: At the proportionate point between the comer of R31E and 32E, T1N and the found stone, set by survey recorded in book 2, page 299, for the corner to Sections 32 and 33. T1N, R32E. I set a 1.25" x 12" galvanized iron pipe with 2.25" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram and 20" below the surface of the ground at the edge of a wheat field just south of the point where the Mill Road turns to go north. The monument was cemented in a hole chiseled into rock. I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 as described below: a rebar bears N32°48'W, 94.27 feet under the west north bound Mill Road right of way fence; a rebar bears N56°41'W, 62.08 feet under the west north bound Mill Road right of way fence: a rebar bears N18°47'E, 20.75 feet at the foot of a power pole; a rebar bears N84°52'E, 120.08 feet at the foot of the "2 mile" mile post paddle; The bearings are true.
