PLS 852 Evidence Found: None Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the location of this corner: At the proportionate point between the corner of R31E and R32E, T1N and the found stone, set by survey recorded in Record of Surveys, book 2, page 299, for the corner to Sections 32 and 33, T1N, R32E. I set a 1.25" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with 2.25" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram and 12" above the surface of the ground. I placed a mound of stone around the monument. The moument is approximately 6' south of an existing fence. I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 as described below: a rebar bears N85°28'W, 65.90 feet under a west bound fence; a rebar bears N83°18'E, 43.14 feet under an east bound fence: a rebar bears N86°49'E, 92.88 feet under an east bound fence; a rebar bears N71°33'W, 16.62 feet under a west bound fence; The bearings are true.
