

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

The corner was originally set by James Currin and James Noland under Special Instructions dated May 4, 1887. Their record states: Set basalt stone 14x12x12, 9 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 on W. face. Lincoln Wilkes in the 1917 survey of the Diminished Indian Reservation states: point falls in road. Set and iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground 45 1/2 links E. of the corner for witness corner to 1/4 sec. cor. with brass cap.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

I found the brass cap by Wilkes protruding 18" out of the ground at the foot of a powerline guy anchor. Ties to survey Q-68-B show that this monument has been moved.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description) At the proportioned point I set a 2 3/8" brass cap on a 1 1/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe, 36 inches in the ground in Goad Road. The cap was stamped as shown in the daigram above.

For references I set two 5/8" x 24" iron rebars with 1 1/4" orange plastic caps stamped WTS and 56295LS as described below:

an iron rebar bears N40°54'52"W 29.27 feet in the west bank of the road; an iron rebar bears S36°43'16"E 45.09 feet on the south side of a sawn off power pole. the brass cap at the East Quarter corner of Section 12, T1N, R32E, bears S0°20'01"E 152.57 feet the brass cap by Lincoln Wilkes (not in its original position) bears N71°48'39"E 26.53 feet; Compass Declination Surveyors Seal

The monument and references were tied using a Trimble R7/R8 RTK GPS system.
