

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by James Currin and James Noland under special instructions dated May 4, 1887. Their record reads:Set basalt stone 16x10x8 ins. marked CC on E. with 4 notches on S. and 2 notches N. faces. Dug pits and raised mound of earth over it. Lincoln Wilkes in his 1917 survey of the Diminished Indian Reservation states: Found basalt stone 14x9x5 marked CC on E. face. Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam. for witness cor. to the closing cor. of secs. 6 and 7, in the center of a lane extending E. and S.

Monument and accessories found. (condition and source)

I found a basalt stone 15x8x6 ins. marked CC on the E. face and 3 notches on the north. There was a 6"x1/2"x15" plow shear driven along the north side.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)
At the corner point I set a 1 1/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above. The cap is 24" below the surface because it falls in the gate to a farmed field.

For references, I set three, 5/8" by 24" iron rebars with 1 1/4" orange plastic caps stamped WTS and 56295LS as described below:

an iron rebar bears N01°17'21"W, 33.89 feet under the existing fence; an iron rebar bears S27°22'36"W, 72.78 feet 20 inches below the surface of a field; an iron rebar bears S27°06'54"E, 74.45 feet 20 inches below the surface of a field; The brass capped monument by Wilkes marking the corner to Sections 1 and 12, T1N, R32E, bears S00°22'32"W 142.45 feet under the existing fence.

The monument and references were tied using a Trimble R7/R8 RTK GPS system.
