Record of Corner Monumentation

History of original corner establishment:

W 1/16 corner Section 14, was monumented by C.E. Redfield during his 1919 circa. He set a 2 ½" brass cap on a 36" pipe in a plowed field.

Description of corner evidence found:

I found no trace of this monument as it is located in a field that has been farmed for many years. No doubt the monument has been destroyed during farming operations.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

I set a 2 ½" Aluminum Cap on a 36" pipe and being stamped as shown in the diagram. I buried the pipe 32" in the ground and placed a large mound of stone around the monument. I also placed a steel fence post in the mound of stone to aid in locating the monument in the future.
