History of original corner establishment:

The most recent original record, by C.E. Redfield, U.S. Indian Service Surveyor, indicates this corner was re-established in 1918 or 1919. Redfield's potes to not state what was set for the corner monument other than a "stake". Redfield's notes were found in the BIA Realty Section vault at the Umatilla Agency.

Description of corner evidence found:

None. After a thorough search of the corner area, the corner position was re-established by double proportion measurement using the Redfield record. The nearest recovered corners North, South, East and West of the corner point were used in proportioning. See Survey No. 92-35-B.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1 1/4" by 30" G.I.P. 31" in ground from which:

A 5/8" by 30" rebar bears N 0° 10' E - 290.00' with a steel fence post set 1' from rebar and a Bearing Object sign attached. A 5/8" by 30" rebar bears N 52° 38'W - 250.08'. Nailed a Bearing Object sign to wood fence corner post near rebar. A 5/8" by 30" rebar bears S 89° 42'W - 356.71' with a steel fence post set 1' from rebar and a Bearing Object sign attached. A 5/8" by 30" rebar bears N 44° E - 30.71' with a steel fence post set 1' from rebar and a Bearing Object sign attached.

All reference corner rebars are capped with a yellow plastic cap marked "W.R. Wells, PLS 1106". Set a steel fence post 3' North of monument with a Survey Marker sign attached.
