

I used a Leica GS18 RTK GPS in the establishment of the new iron pin accessories. Basis of bearing is as per Survey for CTUIR dated May 2019. I use a compass and steel tape for bearing tree accessories. I used 13° East declination. The bearings are to a brass washer marked "OPLS 83571" nailed to the BT blaze for the tree accessories and to the center of the aluminum cap for iron pin. Distances are to a 60D spike nailed to the right side of the base of the tree or the center of the aluminum cap. of the
