

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 24" iron rebar, 22 inches in the ground, with a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap, marked as shown below, from which:

A 16 inch Western larch bears North 6° East, a distance of 60.45 feet, marked W 1/16 S18 BT.

A 16 inch Ponderosa Pine bears South 51° East, a distance of 19.90 feet, marked W 1/16 S19 BT.


Set a steel fencepost approximately 1 foot North of corner monument.
